HAY WAS FEATURE OF LOCAL MARKET

Many Loads Offered and Sales Were Brisk at \$15 a Ton.

SLOW SALE FOR OATS

Other Grains Were in Good Demand—Very Little Fruit Was Offered on the Square This Morning.

Hay was decidedly the feature on this morning's market. There were upwards of 20 loads offered, and the sales were very brisk. Only one load, however, went over the \$15 mark. It brought \$15.50; the remainder went mostly at the former figure.

With the exception of hay the market this morning was inclined to be flat. A few loads of oats were offered, but there was a very slow sale, as most of the buyers are waiting for a better price. One small lot of wheat was offered and found a ready sale at \$1.01, though the demand is not as strong as it was a few weeks ago. There was a fair demand for corn, but the prices were not as high as they were a few weeks ago.

A small load of straw sold for \$5 the load, this being practically all that was offered on the market.
