FOREST GROWTH IN NEW BRUNSWICK

Is Not Keeping Ahead of the Destruction of Growing Trees. Frederickton, March 6.—That New Brunswick's timber supply during the past five years has been reduced by means of the axe, fire and budworm

held last week by Chief Forester G. H. Prince, of the Department of Lands and Mines. Mr. Prince stated that the total estimate of dead lumber resulting from the depredations of the spruce budworm has been placed at between eight and nine billion feet.
