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Burbidge, George Wheelock, A. M., Q. C., D. C. L., Judge of the Exchequer Court of Canada, was born at Canning, N. S., Feb. 6, 1847, and educated at Mount Allison. He was admitted to the bar of New Brun-

wick, June 22, 1872, and was for years member of the law firm of Harrison & Burbidge. On May 22, 1882, he was appointed Deputy Minister of Justice and in Oct., 1887, Judge of the Exchequer Court.

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Burns, Rev. George, D. D., was born in West Lothian, Scotland, and was educated at Edinburgh University. On May 27th, 1817, he took charge of St. Andrews Kirk, St. John, and was the first Presbyterian minister located in the city. Previous to his arrival he had been assistant minister at Aberdeen. In 1831 he returned to Scotland and died at Edinburgh, Feb. 5, 1876, aged 86.

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
