\$2.00 POLL TAX.

- 25. Clause (a) of sub-section (1) of Section 82 of said Chapter 2 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - (a) every male person between the ages of twenty-one and sixty years, residing in such section at the time of holding of such school meeting, shall pay the sum of one dollar (or when ordered by the district board or its committee specified in section fourteen of two dollars) as a poll tax, but no person shall be liable to pay more than one poll tax in any one year.
