

(g) a statement describing the nature of proceedings which have been or are about to be instituted.

6. A request for confiscation shall be accompanied by :

(a) the original or a copy of any order, including any order imposing a fine or pecuniary penalty, in relation to the proceeds of drug trafficking and a summary of the grounds upon which the order was made;

(b) where the person against whom the order is made did not appear in the proceedings, a statement that the person received notice of the proceedings in sufficient time to enable him or her to defend them;

(c) a statement that neither the order nor any conviction to which it relates is subject to appeal;

(d) a description of the property to which measures of confiscation are to be applied including as far as possible the location of the property; and

(e) such evidence as may be required by the Requested Party.
