

Board two years after his sentence or parole has ended. If he was convicted of an indictable offence — which usually means a sentence of more than six months — the waiting period is five years. An inquiry can be made by the Board to see if it recommends to the Governor-in-Council that the inmate be granted a pardon under the Criminal Records Act.
