PRAYERS.

Mr. Leblanc (Laurier) for Mr. Reid, from the Standing Committee on Broadcasting, Films and Assistance to the Arts, presented the Second Report of the said Committee, which is as follows:

Pursuant to its Order of Reference of Wednesday, January 28, 1970, your Committee has considered Bill C-176, An Act to amend the Company of Young Canadians Act and has agreed to report it with the following amendments:

Clause 3

Deleted.

Re-number clauses 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 as clauses 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7.

A copy of the relevant Minutes of Proceedings and Evidence (*Issue No. 18*) is tabled.
