THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA.

BILL 5.

An Act to authorize a further extension of time for the completion of the Saint John and Québec Railway between Gagetown and Westfield.

HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Time for completion of Gagetown to Westfield line extended.

1. The time within which the Saint John and Quebec Railway Company is to complete the construction and 5
equipment of the line of railway from a point at or near Gagetown to a point on the Canadian Pacific Railway at or near Westfield may be further extended by the Minister of Railways and Canals of Canada to the thirty-first day of December, 1919, both with respect to the agreement 10
entered into under the authority of section three of *The Saint John and Quebec Railway Act, 1916*, and also with respect to the subsidy agreement made under the authority of section six of the said Act: Provided that the said extension shall only be granted with respect to the first named 15
agreement after the consent of His Majesty, on behalf of the province of New Brunswick, has been obtained.
