If a notice given for any session of Parliament is not completed in time to allow the petition to be dealt with during that session, the petition may be presented and dealt with during the next ensuing session, without any further publication of such notice. 137. A copy of the said notice and a copy of the petition to be presented shall, at the instance of the applicant, and not less than two months before the consideration by the Committee of the petition, be served personally, when that can be done, on the person from whom the divorce is sought, who is hereinafter called "the respondent."
