(a) In regsed to Tndergradunte Students raking Ordinamy Courses

The number of undereraduatee from 811 faculties ettending ordinary courses in Thysias is at present about 500 . The majority of these students aro attending six oourses, which are repoated in two or more seotions and should be subdivided farther for the best instruction. Seven further gourses (primarily desicned for sdvanced students) are alao attended by aertain ordinary students. in smali numbere. The servicoe of four profesmors, two lecturers, and seven demonatrators are involved in these six larger classes. Thinerous tutorial olasses are ifiven in adartion to these.
(b) In resard to Underaraduato Honours Stadents

The total number of honours students in the second, third, snd fourth years has ranged reaently from ten to fiftech per annyn in number. This important grepup, int ends thelve coursee In Rhysicas, involvinis the services of neamy all the atsff of the butlding.

In this group there have been geventy-four honours craduates siney 1990, of which number tiventy-two lave graduated in the last five yearg. The majority of these are taking an aotive part in the solentific life of the country.
