Gentlemen.

When recently advising Colonel (Rev ) J.M. Almond - Charter Trustees - of the action taken by the Quebec Provincial Headquarters Executive on June 8th to make temporary arrangement for the issue of chaques in the absence of the Fresident and local Vice President Colonel Almond declined to sign a Militia Bond submitted for his signature, and directed my attention to Article 15 of the Fy-Laws, stating that our action was out of order.

As the action taken was taken in good faith and on the pressestion that the Executive were vested with sufficient powers in the provisions of Article 8 and first para, of Article 14 there remained no al ternative but to refer the point raised to the opinion of our Honorary Legal Adviser, who concurs with Colonel Almond.

As a result of our Legal Advisor's ruling I therefore take this early opportunity of advising you that Minute 4. and the Resolution embodied therein, is many null and void and will have to be repealed and adjusted at the next regular Executive meeting.
