I have your letter of the 7th, with reference to the grants to Macdonald College. I am sorry that you have found it necessary to reduce the grant to Macdonald College for the year 1933-34 by \$5,000, but, of course, I can well appreciate the reason, and can sympathize with you, in that you are not able to do all the things you wish to do for agriculture in this Province.

Nevertheless, we shall continue the special investigational work in soil, pasture, vegetables, plant diseases, animal and poultry diseases, drainage, feeding, etc. that has been made possible owing to your support.

I hope that you have fully recovered from your indisposition and that you will be able to get your estimates through the House without undue delay.
