BEACON HILL PARK--

One of the sights of Western Canada in summer, when the broad, breeze-kissed slopes of this fine, natural pleasure ground, secured for the public, is ablaze with the golden Broom—Victoria's floral emblem—one minute's walk from the Hotel.

THE GORGE--

A natural reversible waterfall created by the ebb and flow of the tide through a picturesque minor canyon, with Boating, Bathing, Japanese Tea Garden, Scenic Railway and Dancing Pavilion. Take Gorge car No. 5 sign by day and one green light at night, or can be reached by motor.

THE MALAHAT--

One of the most beautiful rides on the continent—fifty miles of good motor road, overlooking the Saanish peninsula.

GOLF LINKS--

Near the end of Oak Bay Car line, described as the most beautiful Golf Links in the world, commanding a most magnificent view.

UPLANDS--

The finest residential sub-division in Canada. Take Uplands car No. 9 sign by day, and two red lights at night.

FOWL BAY--

A beautiful spot—two miles from the city—fine boating and bathing. Take Fowl Bay cars, No. 5 sign by day and red and white lights at night.

THE WILLOWS--

Soldiers' Headquarters in East end of City. Reached by "Willows Car" or motor.
