

No visitor shall be introduced more than once in six months.

The privileges of visitors may be terminated at the discretion of the Committee.

Visitors may not entertain guests.

Strangers' Room

Any member shall have the privilege of introducing a friend to breakfast, lunch or dine in the Strangers' Room, at his sole expense, and of admitting him, when so introduced, into the Smoking Room and Reading Room, provided the name of such friend shall have been previously inscribed for at least one day in the book to be kept for that purpose. No more than eight persons shall be admitted under this rule, at any one meal, on any one day, and the order of admission shall be regulated by the position of their names in the book; and no other person, not a member, shall be admitted at any time, unless to view the house, and then accompanied by a member. The Committee may in their discretion relax the rigor of this rule as regards previous notice, and the num-
