the administration of the ordinary arfairs of the Dispensary shall be committed.

7. Six of the Managers shall go out in rotation annually, and their places be filled up at the General Meeting of Mana<sub>7</sub> gers.

8. The Managers or a Committee of their number, shall meet quarterly, to receive Reports from the Medical Officers, to authorize Disbursements of Money, and form such occasional regulations as may be necessary.

9. Special Meetings shall be held when never any three Managers, or the Medical Officer shall think them necessary.

10. The Medical Officers shall, for the present, consist of two Physicians, two Surgeons, and two Physician Accoucheurs, all of whose appointmens shall be permanent.

11. They shall give attendance at the Dispensary every day, from Twelve to One o'clock, and shall visit those Patients who may require it in their own houses.

 $12^{\circ}$ . They shall deliver written Reports, of their Department to the Managers at each Quarterly Meeting.

13.<sup>•</sup>. They shall be exempt from the duties of Managers tho'they be Subscribers, but shall be occasionally required to attend the Meetings, and give their advice regarding such improvements as may be suggested in the Medical arrangements.

14°. Each Medical Officer shall be entitled to employ as Clerk a Medical Student, whose appointment shall be subject to the approval of the Managers: and he shall pay one guinea each quarter to the funde
