HUSTLING OFFICERS AT FALLS
MAKE THREE FISH SEIZURESCatch Trains Morning and Evening
and Confiscate a Great
Many Cases.

Niagara Falls, Ont., May 6.—Provincial Fish Overseer Shelley, and his assistant, Howard Lake, are covering all points on the Niagara frontier, where Ontario's forbidden fish are leaking into the markets of the United States.

The officers Saturday morning, at 5.30 o'clock, tied up seven boxes on the Michigan Central Station here that were passing thru to the Niagara Falls Co. at Buffalo. The cases contained pickled (dore), with white fish and mullet from H. Koehler, Dutton, Ont. The whole seven boxes were confiscated.

The pickled were sent to the poor house at Niagara Falls, and the fish that were not subject to the fish regulations were sold.

Last evening Officer Shelley tied off a Bridgeport, and as the Grand Trunk train came into the station at 8.40 p.m. from the west he boarded the express car and found eight boxes containing several bass and other fish, with other fish, four boxes being from the Niagara Fish Co., Buffalo, from A. Hoover, Dunnville, three boxes for Winant & Co., New York City, from W. W. Casey, Wainfleet, Ont., and one box for A. Booth & Co., Buffalo, from H. W. Ainsley, Port Dover, Ont. These were re-addressed and sent to Niagara Falls and placed in cold storage.

The officers then made a quick move back by the American line to this city and covered the Grand Trunk 3.50 a.m. train this morning, but found everything all right. But they also covered the Michigan Central train at 8.30 Sunday morning and ran into another haul of forbidden fish, 33 boxes in all, of mixed fish, many of them subject to the fish regulations.

The whole lot was sent to the Niagara Fish Co., Buffalo, being 13 boxes from Bell, Clark, Ions, Ont., 2 boxes from Johnson and Parish, Ont., 12 boxes from S. F. Randall, Rodney, Ont., and 1 box from P. Campbell, Ridgeway, Ont. Each box contained more or less pickled. The whole lot was put in cold storage. City, from the others confiscated were sent to the poor house.

Local fish dealers have been put out of business temporarily by the seizures the past few days. On this morning the M.C.R. train there were 19 boxes of fish from H. Koehler, Dutton, who had seven boxes confiscated Saturday, but not one fish that came under the ban was in the consignment this morning.

TORONTO FIRMS INTERESTED

S. A. Adler of Montreal Gives Up, With Claims of \$48,000.

Montreal, May 6.—(Special.)—Samuel A. Adler, doing business alone under the name of the Parisian Waist and Shirt Manufacturing Co., St. Lawrence-street, made a judicial abandonment of his estate to Wilkes and Michael, accountants, for the benefit of his creditors, whose claims amount to \$48,000.

CAUSE OF DISASTER PLACED

NO RESPONSIBILITY ATTACHED

Washington, D.C., May 5.—No further steps will be taken to fix responsibility for the fire on the battleship Kearsarge on April 13, which resulted in ten deaths. An opinion handed down by the judge advocate general of the navy, says the finding of the court of enquiry that nobody should be held responsible for the accident seems justified by the evidence submitted.

The judge advocate general reviews briefly the verdict of the court that the accident was caused by a short circuit in the electric circuit and that the fault lies in the fact that the switches and rheostats were installed improperly as to locality and not properly covered. It also was held by the court that while the gunner's mate was the direct cause of the accident he should not be held responsible.

Confirmation at St. Francis'

His Grace Archbishop O'Connor conducted confirmation at St. Francis' (R.C.) Church yesterday afternoon. He was assisted by Rev. Father Klauer. Twenty-seven adults were confirmed, and there were seventeen converts. The closing meeting of the mission in the morning, papal benediction was given by his lordship, at which there were 500 men present.

Receipts of farm produce were light, no grain, 25 loads of hay, 3 loads of straw, with a few dressed hogs and a light lot of potatoes on the market.

Hay—Twenty-five loads sold at \$13 to \$15 per ton for timothy, and \$9 to \$10 for mixed.

Straw—Three loads sold at \$11 to \$12 per ton.

Dressed hogs—Prices firm, at \$9 to \$10 per cwt.

Potatoes—Prices steady at quotations given in table.

Apples—Prices ranged from \$2.75 to \$4.50 per bush.

Butter—Prices are easier at 22c to 27c, with one or two lots going at 20c to special customers.

Eggs—Prices steady at 18c to 20c per dozen, the bulk going at 18c to 19c.

Poultry—Prices firm at 12c to 13c for turkeys, 10c to 11c for chickens, 12c to 14c for good quality, turkeys, 12c to 14c for hens and 15c to 16c for gobblers.

Spring chickens—Prices firm at \$1.25 to \$1.50 per pair, or 40c to 50c per lb.
