ARCH CAMPBELL, M.P., SAFE

Petition Against Him Dismissed and
Avery of Addington Will Hold
His Seat.

HON. E. J. DAVIS IS NOT READY

Motion for Adjournment Will Be
Argued To-Day—Other Charges
in North Oxford.

An examination of Hon. E. J. Davis, for discovery, took place before John Bruce, special examiner, at the City Hall on Friday. Mr. Leonard W. D. McPherson and James Baird appeared for the petitioners, while Mr. Davis was represented by R. A. Grant and T. H. Lloyd. A motion was made by Mr. Davis to have the trial against him postponed. He is not ready, he claims. The motion will come up for hearing at Osgoode Hall to-day.

The petition against Arch Campbell, M.P. for West York, was dismissed at Osgoode Hall on Friday without costs, by Chancellor Boyd and Judge Britton. James Baird appeared for the petitioner, T. F. Wallace, and J. H. Moss for the respondent. No particulars in the case were filed.

The petition against Avery of Addington comes up at Napanee to-day, and will also be dismissed.

Justice Street and Broadway granted an order on Friday to add two new charges to the 112 already made against Donald Sutherland, M.L.A.—elect for South Oxford. One charge is that Donald Sutherland by himself or through Stephen King of Ingersoll, his agent, furnished whiskey, drink, refreshment and other entertainment to Adam Bremner of North Oxford Township; Andrew Howland of West Oxford Township, and to other voters whose names are unknown. The other charge is that a few days before the election at a meeting in Verschoyle the respondent and Stephen King furnished refreshment at the expense of the respondent, or King or E. C. Corbett, a Verschoyle merchant; to M. Romaine, George Wilson, E. Corbett, Bert Hartnett and Samuel Moulton, all of North Oxford Township. It is also charged that this treating was done in the presence of and with the consent of the respondent.

The Canadian Order of Foresters. This purely Canadian fraternal, benevolent and insurance society was organized in 1870 and now has a membership of upwards of 48,000, distributed in every province of the Dominion, to which its operations are confined. The society gives insurance to its members in policies of \$500, \$1,000, \$1,500 or \$2,000, the latter sum being the limit on any life. The premiums payable monthly in advance, are as follows:

After paying towards the premiums and three-quarters in death claims, the order has a surplus in the insurance department of \$1,294,743, at the end of November, 1902. All the money is invested in gilt-edged securities in Canada, or in deposit in the best monetary institutions of the Dominion. Not a dollar of the money collected for the insurance fund is or has been used for the expense of management. The death rate per 1,000 of membership in 1900 was 4.88 and for 1901 4.08, and since the organization of the society the average death rate has been only 4.92.

The Sick and Funeral Benefit Branch is a very popular department and upwards of 24,000 of the members of the society are participating in this feature of the order. The benefits are \$5.00 per week for the first two weeks of illness, and \$5.00 per week for the following ten weeks altogether \$20.00 during any one year, besides a funeral benefit of \$30.00. In case of continued illness, \$5.00 is paid each year in sick benefits. The fees monthly in advance, are as follows:

During the year 1901 over \$71,000 were paid out in sick and funeral benefits, and \$215,000 in death benefits. All physically and morally qualified males, between the ages of 18 and 45 years, who are not disqualified on account of occupation, are accepted for membership.

Tests in Growing Sugar Beets. A report has been made by Prof. Harcourt of the O.A.C. on the results of the tests made in growing sugar beets on experimental plots at Markham, Brantford, Brantford, Guelph, St. Catharines and Orangeville. The percentage of sugar in the juice averaged 16.2, and in the matter of purity scored from 86 to 88. The yield per acre varied from 14 tons 410 pounds, per acre, at Orangeville to 17 tons, 63 pounds at Markham.

Those entitled to vote—Lists to be used are those of the last provincial election, an exception being made of persons who since that time may have ceased to be residents of the province. List of 1902.

Meaning of Liquor Act of 1902.—It prohibits the sale of liquor without a license, except by licensed druggists, but does not prohibit manufacture and export, or sale by manufacturer to licensed druggists.
