ANOTHER RESTAURANT LIFTS DRINK PRICES

Following the lead of the Bowles Company, prices for tea and coffee have been raised to ten cents a cup at the McConkey restaurants, 117 Baitol street and 23 West Queen street. The action taken did not come as a surprise, as Ernest McConkey, the proprietor, had intimated that such a price jump was impending. In the meantime steps are being taken by the civic authorities looking into the contention of the restaurants that the five-cent rate does not permit a profit on the beverages.
