CZAR HAS PRIVATE ORCHESTRA.

It is not generally known, observes a Paris contemporary, that the czar has a private orchestra, which on rare occasions appears in public. This orchestra, we are told, must not be confused with the Imperial Opera of St. Petersburg. The orchestra dates from the time of Alexander III, in 1888, who entrusted its formation to Major General Baron de Stackelberg, himself a composer and skilful musician. All the musicians, in addition to their wages, with board and lodging, are entitled on retirement to a pension.

TYPHOID BREAKS OUT

AGAIN IN MONTREAL

Montreal, Oct. 8.—Typhoid has again broken out in the city, and at present there are more than 100 cases in the hospitals. The outbreak is not confined to any particular district, but is general.

At the Royal Victoria Hospital five applications had to be refused, as all the available accommodation was occupied.

There are forty cases there, and many of the patients are afflicted with a severe type of the complaint. In the experience of the hospital the epidemic has reached high numbers, earlier than last year, and the type is more serious.

At the General Hospital there are twenty-eight cases, and these too have been received from all over the city. Seventeen patients are at the Western Hospital, three being children.

MORTUARY CHAPEL COSTS \$180,000.

The most remarkable mortuary chapel in America is described in an illustrated article in the September number of Popular Mechanics. It is located in Calvary cemetery, Long Island city, New York, and cost \$180,000. The crypts of cats are for the burial of the priests of the diocese of New York, under the charge of which the cemetery is maintained. At present, but one section of the catacombs has been completed with accommodation for twenty-four bodies in the concrete niches. But the section can be extended under ground in four directions, and at any time an addition for seventy-two more bodies can be made. For a central burial there is a lift set into the floor of the chapel to lower the body to the level of the crypts.

The record of burials at Calvary indicates that the mortuary chapel will be in almost constant use. The burials average seventy a day and often run as high as one hundred and twenty.
