is managed by a committee from the city council, and has on its rolls 1 chief, 1 assistant chief, 2 district chiefs, 1 superintendent of alarm telegraph, 1 assistant-superintendent of alarm telegraph, 1 secretary of department, and about 115 men including foremen. There are 15 fire stations in all, the head being No. 1 corner Bay and Temperance streets. The equipment of the whole brigade is of the best, and capable of coping with the worst fires as the following tables shew:

During the year 1892 there were 503 alarms, the greatest number occurring in April and the smallest in August, while the most destructive fires took place in May,

when there were but twenty-eight alarms.

In 1886 the Brigade was called out 274 times, the loss in that year being \$208,902, whereas for the 503 calls of the year 1892 the loss was but \$220,509.
