**START CHANNEL TUNNEL**  
Ex-Deputy's Proposal Has Double  
Object in View

London, Jan. 18.—A former Paris deputy, Gauthier de Clagny, addresses, through the Gaulois, an open letter to the English nation, proposing the immediate beginning of a channel tunnel with the double object of showing the Ger-

mans that the allies are confident that Calais is safe and increasing Anglo-French solidarity.

After pointing out that a German invasion of England would be impossible if half a million French could be rapidly transported to Great Britain, he suggests that as the war of 1870 caused the abandonment of the former tunnel, the present struggle supplies an appropriate occasion to begin the work afresh.

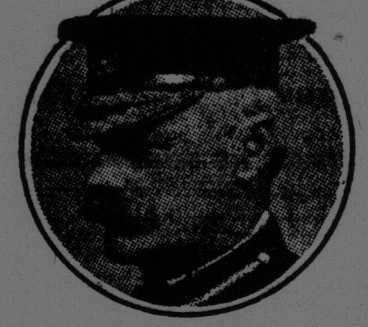

## WHAT OF THIS BILL?

Assessment and Taxation Measure  
Before County Council

Something For the Taxpayers to Think  
Over and Act Upon—A Lot of  
Information Needed at Once

A proposed bill relating to assessment and taxation that might very gravely affect city and county taxpayers is to come up in the Municipal Council tomorrow. A copy of the proposed bill, every section of which should be studied by the taxpayers before tomorrow's meeting, is as follows:

An act to amend the rates and taxes act.

Be it enacted by the lieutenant-governor and legislative assembly as follows:

1. By adding to section 4 of the act, the following sub-section:

(18) The reservoirs connected with the water supply of the city of St. John in the parishes of Simonds and Lancaster and in the city of St. John and the pipes and other constructed works in the said parishes placed in connection with the water system of the city of St. John as well as the water system of the city of St. John in the city of St. John; all the foregoing exemptions should not apply to land held by the city of St. John in the said parishes for overflowage or any other purposes not immediately connected with adjacent, or contiguous with such reservoirs.

2. By adding to section 45 of said 8 George V. Chapter XXI, the following sub-section:

(m) The valuers for the city and county of St. John may secure and are hereby empowered to obtain such other information as they may deem necessary in making a just valuation of all real estate, personal property and income of every person within the city and county of St. John and of all personal property belonging to or held in trust for any person liable to be taxed in the city and county of St. John.

(n) The valuers may secure and set down such other information in addition to the information in subsections 45 of section as they may deem proper.

3. By adding to section 51 the following sub-section:

(1) Notwithstanding any irregularity in the appointment of the board of valuers for the city and county of St. John or any member of the said board, the list of valuations when finally determined upon when filed with the county secretary shall be binding upon the city of St. John and the said parishes of Simonds, Lancaster, St. Martins and Musquash FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS from the first day of January next succeeding the filing of the list of valuations and the board of valuers apportionment or until another valuation shall have been ordered made and filed.

4. All appeals against any assessment made by the various boards of assessors in the parishes of Simonds, Lancaster, St. Martins and Musquash shall be to an assessment committee appointed by the council of the municipality of the city and county of St. John and in the city of St. John to the mayor of the city of St. John.

## TRY 'EM FOR SUPPER, CAKES MADE OF POTATO

Beat three eggs separately, and when the yolks begin to look lemon color add one and a half cups of sugar and beat until very light. Add egg and sugar to the warm potato and beat for three minutes. Flavor with one teaspoon of vanilla and a little nutmeg. Sift five cups of flour with five teaspoons of baking powder. Add one cup of milk to egg and potato and fold in the flour and the whites of three eggs that have been beaten to stiff froth. Take little dough at a time on floured board, cut into shape and fry in deep fat.
