CANADIAN MADE HUGE PROFIT ON CHICAGO MARKET

Arthur W. Cutten, Former Guelph Boy, Cleaned Up \$1,500,000.

A profit of more than \$1,500,000 in a few weeks is not bad. This is the amount which Arthur W. Cutten, Chi cago made on his holdings of July corn which he unloaded at around \$1.10 a bushel. In addition he cleared a half million on wheat in its recent advance of from twenty to twenty-five cents on Chicago and Winnipeg markets.

But this is only adding a fortune to a greater one. His profits, as estimated in Wall street, on the Chicago Board of Trade and the New York Stock Exchange since 1907, when he made his first killing, have been over \$20,000,000. As a speculator he ranks with the great James R. Keene. Alongside of him Jesse Livermore is a piker. There have been times when this quiet man carried as high as 200,000 shares on margin on the New York market. And every dollar of it was his own money. The most of Livermore's vaunted speculation is done with other people's coin. a bushel. In addition he cleared a half

While he attended both public and






