**EXPERIENS USE OF INSULIN.**  
Dr. Bartlett Says it Relieves Diabetes, but Does Not Cure it.  
Philadelphia, July 12.—Diabetic patients may enjoy a ten-course dinner provided they can afford one, without any restrictions as to the kind of food and suffer no ill-effects, according to Dr. Clarence Bartlett, head of the Department of Medicine in Hahnemann Hospital, in which the meal the patient takes a hypodermic of insulin. Dr. Bartlett said that insulin, the newly discovered serum for the treatment of diabetes, injected hypodermically, acts as a solvent of the sugar in the blood. The patient, he declared, is relieved of effects of a superabundance of sugar so long as the serum is present in the system, and for that period his circulation is acting normal.
