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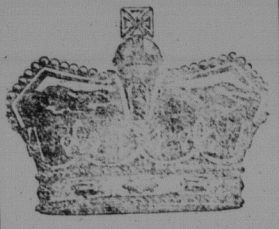

New York, Aug. 9.—Despite heavy spot sales in the foreign market and a rather favorable sentiment toward the market early in the morning, there was considerable pressure directed against the cotton market at the opening this morning which later developed into a wave of selling. Little attention was paid to routine weather news as all interests were busy watching prices crumble further under pressure which appeared to come from all quarters. It looked as if some bull interests who had been surprised by extent and velocity of the recent movement to stand from under till today. Spots appeared as heavy sellers leading color to the story that these interests were selling quickly to buy fresh crop scare that may develop.
