people who elected them to power, the Drary Government or any other government must give at least equal consideration to the claims of their friends and supporters. In the House they will look to the U.F.O. and Labor members for the support necessary to "carry en." It would be suicidal to place a greater reliance and trust in the Opposition than in the members of one's own party. In private life we place our greatest trust in the members of our own household and our friends, and to a large extent the same applies to politics.

There are evils in the patronage system which we are satisfied must be abolished, and that the Drury Government will abolish those abuses. In the first place, Government positions should not be made so remunerative and attractive that there will be a wild scramble to obtain these posts. The majority of these should be placed on a competitive basis and have merit and efficiency in the candidate as the determining factors in making the appointment. There may be exceptional cases where a man has served his country faithfully and long, where a more or less honovary position can be given him, but in the main, government positions placed on a competitive basis and made less attractive in a monetary sense would do away with many of the evils of the patronage system.

G.W.V.A.-Sergt. Flynn Libel Suit

G.W.V.A.-Sergt. Flynn Libel Suit is Well Ended.
