

which the importation Duty Free was intended to be permitted, were omitted to be enumerated, for remedy thereof, it is now Ordered, by His Excellency the Administrator in Chief, by and with the advice and consent of the said Executive Council, that the following articles be added to the list of those enumerated to be imported into this Province by land or inland navigation, viz.

Flour of all descriptions used for making bread.

Indian Meal.

Pork and Beef, fresh or salted.

ALSO,

Provisions of all kinds, and that the same may be imported Free of Duty, but subject to all the other regulations contained in the aforesaid Order of the Twenty-ninth day of May last.

And it is hereby further Ordered, by His Excellency the Administrator in Chief, by and with the advice and consent of the said Executive Council, that the present order be considered as taking effect from the Twenty-ninth day of May last, and that any Duties which may have been collected upon the articles herein enumerated, in consequence of the first Order, be returned by the Collector of the Customs, to the parties from whom he received the same.
