An Act respecting the Kingston and Pembroke Railway Company.

WHEREAS the Kingston and Pembroke Railway Company Preamble. has, by its petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition : Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice 5 and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :--

1. The Kingston and Pembroke Railway Company may lay Line across out, construct and operate a line or branch line of railway from the Ottawa. the town of Renfrew, in the county of Renfrew, across the Ottawa Biver to Bryson, in the county of Pontiac in the

10 Ottawa River to Bryson, in the county of Pontiac, in the province of Quebec, and thence northward to the eastern branch of the Ottawa River.

If the construction of the said railway is not commenced Time for within two years, and the railway is not finished and put in ^{construction}.
15 operation within five years after the passing of this Act, the powers granted by Parliament for such construction shall cease and be null and void as respects so much of the said railway as then remains uncompleted.
