

Conditions.

The several drawings must be accurately followed to their scale (but preference must in all cases be given to figured dimensions over scale) and all notes and explanations wherever they may appear on the drawings must be carefully followed, as they with the drawings are parts of the contract. The whole of the materials used to be of the very best description of their kind. And should the Contractor introduce any materials different from the kind and quality herein described they shall be immediately removed at the Contractor's expense upon notice in writing from the Indian Agent in charge of the Reserve. The Contractor to be responsible for all violations of laws caused by obstruction. The Contractor must give his personal superintendence (or that of a thoroughly practical foreman, who must be approved of by the Indian Agent in charge of the Reserve) until the completion of the contract and the workmanship of the whole work to be executed in the most substantial and workmanlike manner and to the entire satisfaction of the party of the first part or his representative. That in the event of the Contractor becoming bankrupt or failing from any cause to proceed satisfactorily either as regards time material or workmanship then the party of the first part or his representative shall be at liberty after giving three days' notice in writing to
