



On the 21st October the Department wrote to you for a report with regard to the condition of the cattle industry at your Agency. As pointed out in that letter it seems that the Indians have been allowed to sell and otherwise dispose of stock with the result that their individual herds have not been kept up to the proper standard. You should make a full report and furnish explanations in the matter without delay. As intimated in the letter quoted, you should state how you propose to regain the ground which has been lost.
