



This transfer is recommended by return. It looks as if we shall have to try and secure a teacher for Metlakatla for Jan. 1, 1950. I have no one in sight for this position and would be grateful if you would give immediate consideration.

In connection with Kitkatla, it should be said that no children above Grade 1A have been in school since last June. I have no hesitation therefore, in recommending that Miss Monckton move to Kitkatla on the grounds that these children are entitled to at least, half a school year's opportunity in school.
