## APPLICATION OF RATES.

**Class vs. Commodity Rates.** Whenever a carload (or less-than-carload) commodity rate is established it removes the application of the Class Rates to or from the same points on that commodity in carload quantities (or less-than-carload quantities, as the case may be). Applies only on Interstate Traffic.

**Distance vs. Specific Rates.** If the use of the distance tariff on pages 4 and 5 of this tariff make a lower charge on any shipment than the specific rates shown in this tariff such lower charge will apply.

**Rates on Commodities** are specific and must not be applied on analogous articles.
