N—North.

S—South.

E—East.

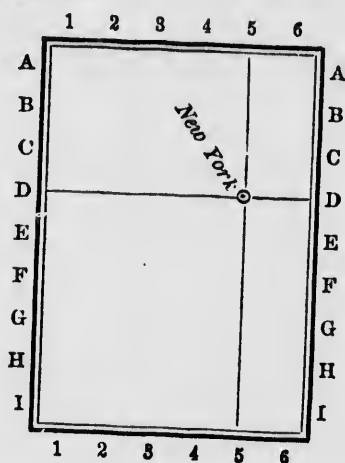
W—West.

Towns marked thus * are recently established Post Offices, location not definitely known.

The figures before names of towns denote population, either census of 1870, or estimated.

The letters and figures following names, refer to that point on the map at which lines drawn from marginal figures top and bottom, and letters upon either side of map, would cross each other at right angles.

For example, to find "New York City D 5," let the diagram below represent the map. New York is seen near the crossing of lines D—D and 5—5.



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
