

ARTICLE VI.

Whenever any vacancy shall occur in the Board of Direction of the Society, it may be filled by a special election of the said Board, at such time as they may deem expedient, of which one month's notice shall be given by the Secretary-Treasurer in writing to each member of the said Board.

ARTICLE VII.

The duty of the President shall be to preside at all meetings of the Society; to maintain order; to state the business before the Society; in case of equal division upon any question to give the casting vote; to call for accounts and reports of all Committees; to call extra meetings of the Society, when requested, in writing, by five members; and generally to superintend the execution of such by-laws and regulations as the Society shall from time to time enact, not otherwise provided for.

ARTICLE VIII.

In case of the absence of the President at any meeting of the Society, it shall be the duty of the Vice-President to take the chair, and in his absence, the Second Vice-President, who, for
