Quebec Railway was the most active stock, and a good business was done in it at improving figures. Rumour has it booked for a somewhat higher level. Dominion Steel Corporation was second in point of volume of trading, and closes better then the low level of the week. Asbestos Comcloses better then the low level of the week. Asbestos Common also figured prominently at a somewhat better price, but the market for this stock is not wide, and it is a waiting purchase, but may show good results for those willing to wait for returns patiently. Crown Reserve selling ex-dividend was very inactive, the total sales involving only 1,650 shares. Mackay Common was a strong spot, and advanced over 96 on small sales. The Bank of England rate remains at four per cent. at four per cent.
