consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The said corporation, known as "The High School of Or whom the Quebec," shall be composed of, firstly: All the persons who to be composed. have respectively paid one half of any share of the original stock of the said Association, and who are hereby discharged from any further payment to the said corporation on account of the stock aforesaid; secondly: Of all persons who shall before the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and sixtysix, have respectively subscribed and paid not less than fifty dollars to the fund for erecting the building aforesaid; and thirdly: Of all persons who may hereafter be admitted as members of the corporation under the by-laws thereof.

2. No Member of the said Corporation shall, as such, derive No pecuniary any pecuniary profit or benefit from the funds of the school.

3. The said corporation shall have power to pass by-laws, corporation rules and regulations, as provided for by the provisions of the may poss first section of the said Act of Incorporation of the may poss by-laws. first section of the said Act of Incorporation, at any meeting of the corporation, duly called, at which at least one fourth of the members of the said corporation, resident in Quebec, shall be present.

4. This Act shall be deemed to be a Public Act.

CAP. L.

An Act to amend the Act to incorporate the Education Society of the District of Quebec.

[Assented to 18th March, 1865.]

WHEREAS the Education Society of the District of Preamble. Quebec, a body politic and corporate, incorporated under and by virtue of an Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the seventh year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled : An Act to incorporate the Education Society of the District of Quebec, has by its petition represented that it is necessary that the sixth section of the said Act should be repealed: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- 1. From and after the passing of this Act, the sixth section of Section 6 of the said Act shall be and remain repealed.
 - 2. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
