SUCCEED AT MONCTON ON 4TH NOV.—Tim Holland, an inmate of the almshouse, and a native of Woodstock, N. B., committed suicide with a razor. Last August Holland being in poor health here, asked for admission to the almshouse, which was granted. During the last few days he continually kept asking for a razor to shave himself. To day, having again asked, another inmate, Lazarus Gallant, brought one. He laid the razor down and asked Gallant to go and see what time it was. Gallant went, and on his return found the man dead on the bed with his throat cut from ear to ear. The razor was lying by his side. A frightful gasp four inches in length was made completely severing the jugular vein. Death was instantaneous. The deceased was about 33 years old. His health was wasting fast during the worst stage of consumption. He was not expected to live over three weeks.

NEW MACHINERY PUT IN.—S. R. Foster & Son, manufacturers of wire and steel nails, tacks, etc., have determined to keep up with the times in every way possible. Their business has never been better than during the past season but in order to facilitate the work and enhance the value of their goods this firm has recently purchased new machinery. They have just introduced Miller's torpedo nail picker. Heller & Co., Mill street manufactured the machine, but the model was furnished by Mr. Miller, foreman of the Harris rolling mills. It is a cylinder in shape. The nails are placed into one end and by the rotation of the machine. All the nail heads dropped into one box and the good ones into another.
