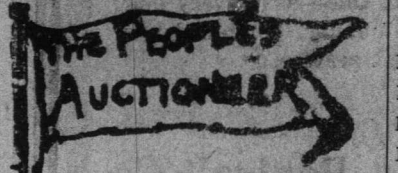

PUBLIC NOTICE!

Under the Provisions of the Stamp Duties Act, 1914, and the Act in amendment thereof and the Regulations issued thereunder, all receipts for any sum of money exceeding ten dollars must be stamped by the issuer thereof.
Any person issuing a receipt without a stamp for the amount of the duty payable thereon shall be subject for the first offence to a fine not exceeding ten dollars. For the second offence to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars, and for the third and subsequent offence to a fine of two hundred dollars, and in default of payment of such fine shall be subject to imprisonment not exceeding one month for the first offence, three months for the second offence and one year for the third and every subsequent offence.
