## ASK PROVINCIAL CONTROL OF GAS

Members of Woodstock City Council Take Definite Stand On Issue.  
MINISTER IS NOTIFIED  
Aldermen Fear Repeal of Act Would Lead To Monopoly.  
Special to London Advertiser.  
WOODSTOCK, April 5.—Any movement to oppose the repeal of the natural gas conservation act is opposed by the Woodstock City Council, who fear that the repeal of the act would place the border cities who have contracts for cheap gas in control of the supply. The abolition of the position of natural gas referee is, however, favored by the council, who would prefer the appointment of a commission of three to fix the rates. The council is also in favor of the government retaining control of the gas fields and the distribution of the gas. The minister of mines has been notified to this effect.  
Ernest Lane died in the General Hospital today. Deceased, who came to this country from England, had been employed at the Ontario Hospital here. He is survived by his wife and mother of this city.  
The winners have been declared in the debating contests that have been in progress at the collegiate for some time. Russell Orth and Irwin Loscoe won the "junior boys' series; Margaret Farrell and Marie Henderson, the junior girls' section, while Eleanor Blair and Bessie Bastedo won the girls' series.  
Dr. Gertrude Hulet, a returned missionary from Kiana district, Madras, and a native of Norwich, in a lecture here, stated that "even the temple girls of India would be shocked to see the men and women of this country jazz dancing." The Oxford missionary stated that the temple girls, at that, belonged to the lowest caste in India. These girls dance to jazz, she said, but not with men. Dr. Hulet made an earnest plea for more medical assistance for the women and children of India.  
Work on the land in this district, it is expected, will commence next week, and the farmers are now getting hasting anxious to secure help. Many applications have been received at the local department of agriculture, especially since the recent storm, which has also created work on the farms. Forty dollars a month and board for a competent single man was offered by one farmer today, but the average wage is \$25 to \$40 a month.

## CEASE OPERATING LINDSAY ARSENAL

LINDSAY, April 5.—The whistle of the Dominion Arsenal in Lindsay has ceased to blow. All work has stopped and 150 hands let out of employment. Many are returning to Quebec, from whence they came, and will be given work in the Quebec Arsenal. Some of the machinery is also being shipped to Quebec. This up-to-date plant, with a number of very fine buildings is now waiting for some manufacturing concern to occupy.
