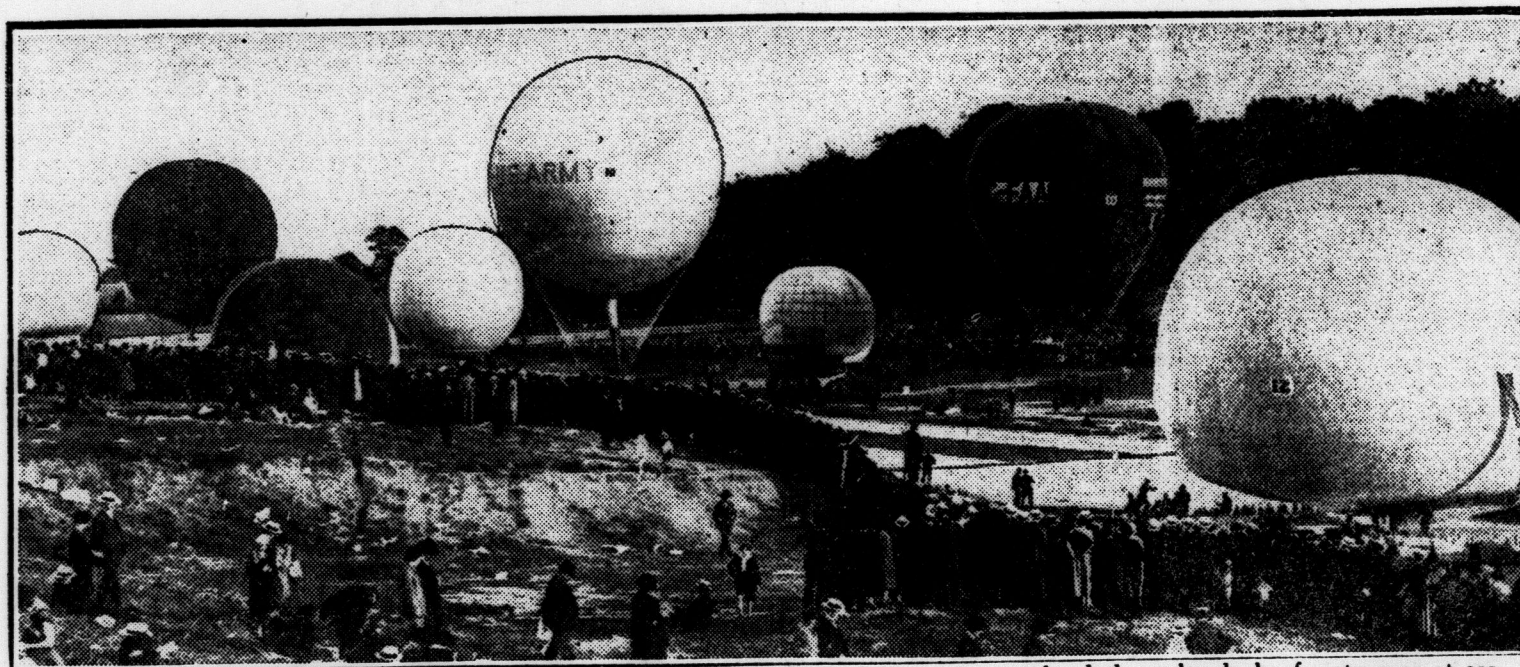


Indians Adopt Beauty; Huge Tarpon Catch; Big Balloon Race

Off for their summer holidays. While Daddy gets the tickets, Big Brother minds Baby Sister and the baggage



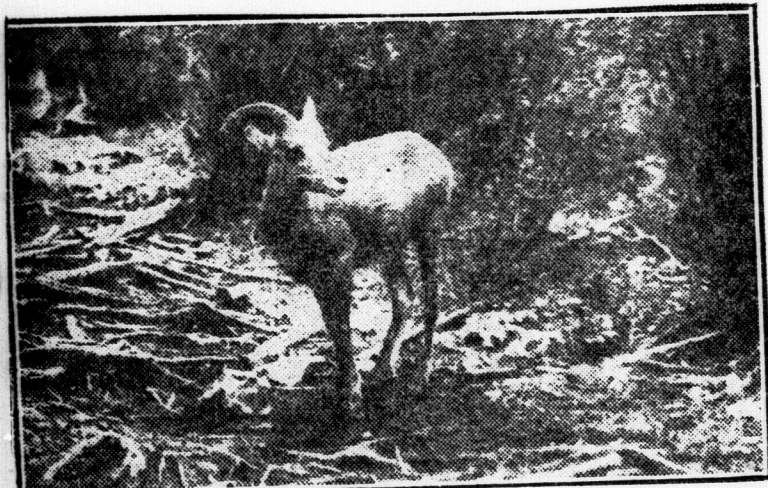

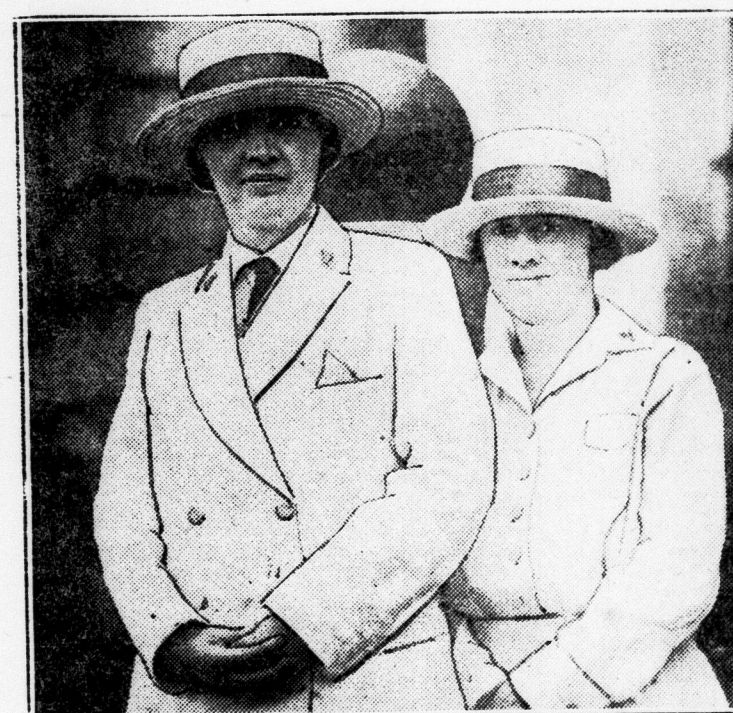
Very mannish is this coat of cheviot in a combination of black and powder blue with a spinach green decoration in a parquetry design. It captured the honors at a New York display
