

HORSE, HITCHED TO WAGON, FOUND DEAD TIED TO TREE

FREDERICTON, Sept. 21.—The result of what was a very brutal and inhuman act was discovered yesterday in the postage woods between the 2nd and Bolton streets and about three-quarters of a mile from the main postage road. It was the dead body of a horse tied to a tree and hanged to a wagon. The horse had evidently been drawn up to the tree and tied there by the driver who walked off and allowed the poor animal to remain there until it died.

About a month ago Chief of Police Hamilton received word from the chief of police at Chatham that a horse and wagon had been stolen and that the parties who took it were on their way to this city. The chief drove out the road and made every effort to locate the men but without success. Chief Hamilton was certain that the men did not drive past him and come to this city, although such an idea prevailed at the time among parties at Chatham.

The horse and wagon found in the woods corresponds to the description of the same stolen and is undoubtedly the same. It therefore appears that the parties who stole the rig instead of driving through to this city, left the horse to die at this lonely spot in the woods and took a trail through the forest, coming out at some other point.

HOPETOWN

The inspector gave a reading on English as it should be taught. That the teachers may have the same standing for the better judgment of inferior work, it was suggested that a standard set of questions be set for all elementary schools. The teachers were entertained at luncheon at Caldwell's hotel.

LIQUOR RAIDS CAUSE SMALL RIOT IN BANGOR

BANGOR, Sept. 21.—Five Sunday, September 20th, a riot in Picketing street, Bangor, was caused by the liquor raid. Frank S. Cox and Sheriff Deane Benjamin Towse, of Waterville, was assaulted by one of the proprietors. After a scuffle both were handcuffed together and led through the streets to the police station followed by a crowd of 200, who shouted the depreciable and abusive epithets. Sergeant Smith at the head of a squad of policemen, charged the crowd and the hostile demonstration stopped. It stood in front of city hall for fully half an hour, and only backed a leader to push it into a mild riot against the enforcement commission. No one was hurt.




