

this fund, who shall be considered as Church Society Missionaries, Catechists, &c., and entered as such in the annual report, with the sums granted to them.

Your committee would further recommend that the Missionaries and all other persons who are paid or assisted from this fund, be required, as a condition of their being continued on this fund, to make quarterly reports to the bishop, for the information of the society, of the work done by them, with any facts connected with the work of the Church which may be interesting; which reports, or abstracts of them, shall be published in the annual report, or in any other manner if thought desirable, at the discretion of the standing committee.

All reports to be sent in on the 1st February, May, August, and November of each year.

Your committee would recommend that all payments from this fund, made according to the proposed arrangement, shall be paid quarterly, at the same periods as the payments from the commutation fund, and in the same way.
