A NUX VOMICA CASE.

My Picric acid case being published in your issue of September last, I venture to send you another case for publication. It seems more important to me, as the patient himself is an allopath.

Mr. G. N. Das, then Assistant Surgeon, S-, was suffering from inveterate (the term being his own) dyspepsia for eight months. Formerly he had been in the habit of taking milk and butter in abundance, the other articles of food being not readily available at his station, but his illness caused milk to disagree. He had occasional attacks of abdominal pain, causing him to lie down for several hours, even sometimes a day or more. The bowels are habitually constipated. He was afraid of taking a liberal diet, which caused flatulence and pain.
