Eight movements of incoming and outgoing convoys have been recorded by the International Commission's Teams after 20th November, 1954. Only six of them were, however, checked; of the remaining, one was notified too late and the other had departed earlier than foreseen. It has been reported that the main reason for the delay in notification is the fact that some of the convoys consist of civilian vehicles and that the civilian companies do not stick to schedule. It is to be noted, however, that the bulk of the stores so far reported to have entered Laos were engineering equipment necessary for road-building and bridging.
