— Statistics Canada, in its release, noted that reconciled figures for 1985 show Canada posted a record surplus of \$21.5 billion in merchandise trade with the United States. The surplus had previously been estimated at \$18.6 billion by Canada and \$29.7 billion by the United States. Since 1976, Canada has reported a reconciled merchandise trade surplus with the United States and for the past six years it has increased annually — most notably since 1982.
