

21. The Mexican side asked the Canadian side to increase the number of scholarships for Mexican citizens.

The Canadian side took note of this proposal and will study the possibility of approving it.

### III. ART AND CULTURE

22. The Instituto Nacional de Bellas Artes [National Fine Arts Administration] (INBA) extended an invitation to Canadian institutions, artists, and cultural and artistic groups to participate in the activities being organised to mark the 50th anniversary of the Palacio de las Bellas Artes [Museum of Fine Arts] in September, October, and November of 1984.

In addition, it asked that the Canadian side approach various museums and galleries in Canada in order to obtain the loan, for a period of not more than 60 days, of two master works from different centuries representing Canadian art and culture, to be shown at the great international exhibition "Obras Maestras de los Museos del Mundo" ["Master Works from the Galleries of the World"].

One of the works should have been shown during the past 50 years, as testimony to the cultural work that has been carried on by the Instituto Nacional de Bellas Artes.

The Canadian side expressed its thanks for this invitation, and indicated that it is planning cultural activities for participation in this anniversary celebration.

With regard to Canadian participation in the Obras Maestras de los Museos del Mundo exhibition, the Canadian side took note of the INBA's request.
