EXCHANGE OF NOTES BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA CONSTITUTING AN AGREEMENT TO EXTEND THE NORTH AMERICAN AEROSPACE DEFENCE COMMAND (NORAD) AGREEEMENT FOR A FURTHER FIVE-YEAR PERIOD

Sir:

I have the honor to refer to the Exchange of Notes of March 11, 1981, (1) which became effective for a period of five years on May 12, 1981, and to recent discussions that have taken place between representatives of our two Governments regarding future cooperation between the United States and Canada with respect to the North American Aerospace Defense Command (NORAD) Agreement.

I have the honor to propose that this Note and your reply shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments to extend the NORAD Agreement for a further five-year period, effective from May 12, 1986.
