Polyester/Rayon Fabrics are, subject to the over-riding definition for polyester/cotton fabrics, woven fabrics in which the rayon and polyester fibres in combination account for 50 per cent or more by weight of the fabric.

Polyester/Cotton Broadwoven Fabrics: woven fabrics made from blends of cotton and polyester fibres, where polyester fibres represent 50 per cent or more by weight. (South Korea)

Woven fabrics in which the cotton and polyester fibres, in combination, represent 50 percent or more by weight, whether uncoated or coated (i.e., where the coating accounts for less than 50 per cent by weight). Excluded are denim and corduroy fabrics. (China)

Fabrics made from blends of cotton and polyester fibres, where polyester fibres in combination with cotton fibres represent 50 per cent or more by weight. This item excludes denim and corduroy. (Hong Kong)

Woven fabrics in which the polyester and cotton fibres in combination account for 50 per cent or more by weight. Denim fabrics and corduroy fabrics are excluded from this definition. (Taiwan)

Denim Fabrics (Hong Kong)

Woven fabrics of a 2 by 1 or 3 by 1 twill construction made of cotton yarns and/or polyester/cotton yarns with the warp yarn dyed, normally blue, brown or black, and with a white filling yarn. (Taiwan)

Worsted Fabrics are woven fabrics having 17 per cent or more by weight of wool in which at least the warp is made from worsted spun yarn.

Nylon Fabrics: broadwoven fabrics in which the nylon fibre accounts for 50 per cent or more by weight or thread count or where the nylon fibres represent the chief value. (South Korea)
