

A University-to-university exchange for students as well as faculty. The exchange is open to members of all university departments. In 1994, three Augsburg students studied at Carleton and three Carleton students came to Augsburg.

At Augsburg, students are selected by the Institute for Canadian Studies, at Carleton by a committee of representatives of the university.

For Canadian students, there is a "DAAD-Kontaktstipendium", i.e. a grant which, apart from a tuition waiver, includes a monthly allowance of DM 400 to DM 940. Travel costs are paid by the students. German students benefit from a tuition waiver but have to pay travel costs and accommodation. German students may be offered a teaching assistantship if this is in accordance with Canadian labour regulations.

Students remain enrolled at their home university but usually apply for leave status.
