CANADIAN DELEGATION TO PRESIDENTIAL INAUGURATION IN EL SALVADOR

The Deputy Prime Minister and Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Allan J. MacEachen, announced today the composition of the Canadian delegation to the inaugural ceremonies of the new president of El Salvador, His Excellency José Napoleon Duarte. The Canadian delegation will be led by Mr. Maurice Dupras, Member of Parliament, who will be accompanied by the Canadian Ambassador to El Salvador, Mr. Francis Filleul.

The inaugural ceremonies of President Duarte will take place in San Salvador on May 31st, June 1 and 2,1984.

The Canadian Government had accepted the invitation of the Salvadoran government to send observers to each of the two rounds of the presidential elections that brought Mr. Duarte to power on March 25 and May 6, 1984.
