PRAYERS.

The Order being read for the second reading and reference to the Standing Committee on National Resources and Public Works of Bill C-161, An Act to provide for the dissolution of the Dominion Coal Board and for the repeal of the Canadian Coal Equality Act, the Coal Production Assistance Act and the Dominion Coal Board Act;

Mr. Greene, seconded by Mr. Cadieux (Labelle), moved,—That the said bill be now read a second time and referred to the Standing Committee on National Resources and Public Works.
